#### A. Use of Low Power Itinerant Channels

Chief Nelson explained the proposed use of these channels in analog for interoperability, citing Oakland and Macomb border fire departments as an example. He proposes four tiers

in a template: 8TAC, 7TAC1, 7TAC2 and DTAC (simplex, or direct). Applications will be needed to place these in subscriber units. Chief Nelson will develop language.
