Mr. Briggs stated that MDOT's greatest issue was the equipment at the international bridge in Sault Ste. Marie. Mr. Fyvie discussed the value of a pre-narrow band baseline study of coverage.

Ms. Coates advised that Oakland had agreed to an FRA, but cannot determine a schedule, as other licensees need to re-band first.
