1. State of MI – 8505 Escanaba

2. State of MI – 8905 Powers

Mr. Farrer explained that the MPSCS has received the Letter of Concurrence from Region 45. Motion by Wolf, supported by Cribley, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

B. New Applications

1. State of MI – River Central, Grand Traverse

Mr. Ogbanna explained that the application relicenses three existing frequencies on the Clinton County system to the MPSCS, as Clinton is merging the systems. **Motion** by Cribley, supported by Imeson, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

2. State of MI – Gratiot County

Mr. Ogbanna explained that this is a fill in site to for three channels already existing on the County's system at Rainbow Lake to enhance coverage. Mr. Bradshaw stated that, although Region 45 concurrence is not required, it is close enough to the line that the applicant should notify Region 45. **Motion** by Hasil, supported by Cribley, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.
