A. Interoperable Communication Subcommittee

Mr. Bradshaw provided an update of the UASI ICC meeting. The Oakland County system will utilize AES256 encryption for law enforcement, will fire talk groups clear. AES256 will be the standard for statewide patching. Lt. Zdybek will be presenting patching and encryption at the MI Interoperability Conference.

B. Engineering/Technical Subcommittee

Mr. Farrer stated that the MPSCS upgrade at the PSAPs is almost complete, and data will be the next step. Ms. Clemente advised that the DNR is experiencing some issues, and will forward details to Mr. Farrer.
