A. State of MI – Rothbury SOW

VIII. 800MHz Subcommittee Reports

A. Interoperable Communication Subcommittee

Mr. Bradshaw reported that he now has contact information for Region 14. He updated the committee on an exercise in Algonac in which the Oakland County Sheriff Department used a TAC repeater that was able to work off the Open Sky system. He recommends that the MPSCS utilize TAC repeaters and statewide training. He suggested that the committee look at the 201 map in the 800 Plan, which Mr. Farrer said should still be accurate.

B. Engineering/Technical Subcommittee

Mr. Farrer advised of a new project, adding DSR to the core for dynamic system resilience. This includes juniper router upgrades and additional redundancy using CENS as a second path.

C. 800 MHz Plan Update Standing Subcommittee

Mr. Bradshaw discussed the obsolete S160 agreement for use of Federal talk groups, which is still included in the Plan but no longer used.

B. 4.9 GHz

Mr. Williams stated that everything is still frozen until the "band manager" is appointed. Incumbents can still apply for renewals, but the FCC is not accepting new applicants.

C. Other

Mr. Bradshaw provided an update on the Oakland new system, which is functional on 14 out of 16 channels, as two are still on Open Sky. Coverage testing started May 1 with 6 days of drive testing and 100 buildings tested for in building -18 dBu coverage. Connectivity is still being worked on.
