1. State of MI – Barton City

The application is for 851.225 at a site in Alcona County, and to add mobiles, portables and control stations to an existing call sign. Contours are clear. **Motion** by Mlujeak, supported by wolf, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

i. State of MI – Black River

The application is to add mobiles, portable and control stations to an existing site in Alcona County. **Motion** by Cribley, supported by Mlujeak, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

3. State of MI – Ingham County Simulcast

The application is for 3 channels on 9 sites on an ancillary system to the MPSCS. Mr. Bradshaw advised that the channels 851.225 and 851.125 impinge on the wide band channels in Oakland County, and 851.725 may have issues with Wayne and Saginaw Counties. He discussed the differences between interference contours and service areas. Lenawee can take action, such as reducing ERP, or obtain letters of concurrence from the impacted counties. MPSCS stated that they would seek the letters of concurrence or, if unsuccessful, consider reducing ERP Per Mr. Bradshaw, the application was tabled.
